Programme Overview

The Diploma consists of an induction workshop followed by 7 face to face workshops and an end of course Chartered Manager assessment.

How is the Programme Assessed?

Each unit is assessed by a project where candidates will be asked to demonstrate how learning has been applied to work-based practice.

How much does it cost?

The 7-unit level 5 Diploma, integrated with Chartered Manager assessment costs \pounds 1,828 per person for local authority members of Scotland Excel, \pounds 2,011 for associate members and \pounds 2,194 for other public-sector candidates.

Where will the Programme be delivered?

There will be approximately 1-2 months between delivery of each unit. The face to face workshop delivery will be tailored to specific group needs and location once demand is confirmed.

How much time will it take me?

The diploma is comprised of 7 units, totalling 42 SCQF credits. The SCQF works on the basis that 1 credit = 10 hours of effort and therefore, it would be expected that completion of the diploma programme would require a total of 420 hours of effort.

What qualification will I receive if successfully completed?

On successful completion of the programme, candidates will receive the Management Coaching and Mentoring Diploma at Level 5 (SCQF8).
