







Executive Summary

This document illustrates a snapshot of The Academy's people development and organisational development activities, including the schedule of programmes and workshops.

The Academy is delivering accredited programmes developing 28 of 32 (88%) councils and 18 Public / Third-Sector organisations nationally –

- o 821 registered learners
- o 170 active learners engaged in accredited programmes across 8 cohorts
- o 24 cohorts have now been completed
- 149 qualifications have been awarded. Several cohorts remain in the final assessment stage so the awarded qualification numbers do not yet include these
- o 7 new cohorts are planned
- o 469 learners have participated in non-accredited one-day development workshops
- 630 learners have now participated in the Stay Connected one-hour online workshops
- o 6 learners have been awarded Chartered Manager (CMgr)

Combining our accredited programmes and non-accredited workshops, The Academy is engaging 31 of 32 (97%) councils and 40 public/third-sector organisations in development activities.


These Chartered Managers join an elite group of ~700 Scottish Chartered Managers, within a population of ~10,500 Chartered Managers globally (CMI September 2020).


